Supervisory Commission Preliminary Report 2006-2007

Activity Report 1st October - 31st March

Elected members of the Disciplinary Commission are: Raluca Teodor (Romania), Jonas Friedrich (Germany) and Alessio Sanguinetti (Italy). Internal division, according to the Internal Rules, for the first period, was Jonas Friedrich as president, Raluca Teodor as Prosecutor and Alessio Sanguinetti as Defendant.

The interaction between members has been always guaranteed through internet (e-mail and messenger) on a regular basis. The members are based in different countries, doing different activities, therefore e-communication (together with sms) has always produced very good results.

During the first semester the Commission only had two cases to face, both in the beginning of the mandate.

The first case produced a private warning, therefore the Commission cannot present many details on the case. There were some disputes among present and past members of some IAPSS bodies and some of the e-mails were wrongly distributed in the iapss_members mailing list. On the basis of self-action - as stated in the Internal Regulations - the Commission, been aware of the ongoing situation through the mailing list, decided to issue a private warning to the people mostly involved in the 'quarrel'. The decision to issue a private warning was reached after a common session of the Commission. The three members, having studied the case, met on the messenger in order to commonly reach an agreement and the result was the decision to issue a private warning. The text was written and sent only to the people involved in the case. The dispute stopped and the case was archived.

The second case concerned the crisis followed to the resignation of the majority of the members of the Executive Committee. In this case the role of the Disciplinary Commission was to support a quick solution of the crisis. Therefore, together with the remaining members of the Executive Committee and the Supervisory Committee, the Disciplinary Commission helped organising and supervising the first e-GA, which resulted in the election of new members of the ExCom.

On 1st February, according to the Internal Regulations, the new division of tasks is: Raluca Teodor - President, Alessio Sanguinetti - Prosecutor, Jonas Friedrich - Defendant.
