Mission, vision, values and the organizational chart are part of the Strategic Plan. The Operational Plan is developed for the period of one (1) year. It details specific objectives of the Strategic Plan. It is developed, adopted and implemented by the Executive Committee.

It details specific objectives of the Strategic Plan. It is developed by the ***elected*** Executive Committee ***prior to the beginning of its mandate. The ExCom in office is to assist the elected ExCom in the development of the Operational Plan. The Operational Plan is adopted and implemented by the Executive Committee once it begins its mandate.***
