References should follow these rules:

1. Articles:

Last name, Name. Year of publishing. Title of the article. *Journal* Volume(issue):pages .

Example:

Dixon, William J. 1981. The Emerging Image of U.N. Politics. *World Politics* 34(1):47-61.

2. Books:

Last name, Name. Year of publishing. *Title of the book.* Place of publishing: Publisher.

Example:

Huntington, Samuel P. 1996. *The Clash of Civilizations and the Remaking of World Order.* New York: Simon and Schuster.

3. Compendiums

Last name, Name. Year of publishing. Chapter. In *Title of the book*, edited by Name Last Name, pages. Place of publishing: Publisher.

Example:

Katzenstein, Peter J. 1996. Conclusion: National Security in a Changing World. In *The Culture of National Security: Norms and Identity in the World Politics*, edited by Peter J. Katzenstein, 498-537. New York: Columbia University Press.
